Kelly Brinkmann is a speaker, writer and handmade artist. Her story with Jesus started in her teen years and grew as a young adult serving as a church youth director and Christian camp counselor in college.

Throughout her career, Kelly applied her BA in studio art to use creative thinking and problem-solving skills in a variety of non-profit and corporate leadership positions. Her travels around the globe have given her stories and encounters with people in all walks of life.

Along the way, her art studio, Art & Souls Creative Studio, has allowed Kelly to use handdrawn teaching tools and pottery as tangible reminders of how the Creator is molding and making us every day and how, like clay, He forgives us.

Kelly's joy for Jesus shines brightest when she's connecting with women and describing how He is always working for their good. **Creating a full pottery studio on-stage, Kelly speaks and teaches at conferences illustrating biblical truths with simple art tools in a powerful way.** (Fun fact: Her upcoming book will share more about her parables linking spiritual truths and art object lessons.)

Enhanced Worship Experience

- Add visual art to worship to enhance individual experience
- Two canvas banners with hand-painted illustrations used as teaching tools on the worship platform (free standing 49in. wide x 92in. tall x 54in. deep base)
- **Professional photo backdrop** with turquoise barn wood image on the platform invites attendees into the teaching space (10 ft x 10 ft, can be folded and hung between canvas banner stands)
- Attendees get to be an active part of the pottery-making process when they participate in reclaiming pottery
- Samples of **completed pottery** on a display table in the foyer so attendees can see the whole process of making pottery from beginning to end, wet clay to bisque fired, glazed and glaze fired. (Retail of finished art is available, if permitted.)

You'll get **file downloads** for an illustrated note page and two handdrawn coloring Scripture bookmarks that can be printed and provided to your attendees as complimentary take-away teaching tools.








Remade and Reclaimed: Understanding Who Jesus Is In Your Life

Wheel-thrown pottery is a visual illustration of how the Lord prepares us to meet him, how He centers our life with peace and purpose and opens us up to align our heart with His. Using His truth as the measure of goodness, audiences see how to grow in their relationship in Christ knowing He is at work to refine us with each touch.

While wheel-thrown pottery captures the attention of all of those watching vessels being made right before their eyes, it is the process of reclaiming clay that captures their hearts.


As the artist reclaims old and dried out clay in a simple bucket of water to make new, usable clay, the audience sees how their own spiritual life can be remade each time they turn over their own sins and failed efforts to the Lord. When clay is reclaimed, it is ready to be made into a new artwork, designed to fulfill its purpose. Signature & Themed



Made for More: How to Become Who God Created You to Be

In Jesus, we were made to experience the fullness of life utilizing all of the gifts, skill and experiences entrusted to us. Sometimes outside voices speak loudly and often threatening to drown out Truth about who we are and whose we are. Without training, it can be easily to be thrown off center and start believing false words and thoughts about ourselves.

Through this message, Kelly recalls stories of her travels through Europe and how selling her first work of art in Amsterdam helped her see who she really was in Christ. As a host, you'll provide the following:

Two-three strong people to lift the pottery wheel and a prepared path from the parking area through doorways that are large enough to fit the wheel measuring 34" tall x 30" wide x 44" long, weighing 210 lbs. (I'll bring a wheeled cart.) I'll bring a large canvas drop cloth for the speaking area.

Access to water to fill buckets of water

Stage area or raised platform to allow pottery-making to be seen by all attendees while it's being created. (Note: The wheel is a kick-wheel so does not require electricity.)

Three 6-foot tables: one table on stage as a wedging table and two tables for finished pottery display area in the back of the room or in the foyer. I'll provide the table cloths. Retail sales of finished art is available so attendees can take home a token to remember the message.

Live camera feed focusing on my hands throwing pottery. (This is not a requirement, but is preferred, when possible.)

Connection with the worship team to create a powerful, unified worship experience. At the end of the spoken message during the time of invitation, worship team is needed to play instrumental music leading into a song encouraging attendees to respond to the message.
